Located in Victoria County, Cape Breton Island, Nova Scotia.

Reached from the Warren Lake ranger station on the Cabot Trail, by driving northwesterly on one of the Park roads to the fire road that passes by the Lake of Islands and Dundas Lakes. In 1963 it was possible to take a "bom bardier" along the fire road to within 700 yds. of the station. After passing Dundas Lakes continue westerly for 2 1/2 miles along the fire road leading to Cheti camp. The station is on a barren hill about 1200 yds. west of the next large lake. Take the fire road that swings to the north of this lake and about a mile past the lake climb to the summit of the hill south of the fire road.

Marked by a standard monument with bronze tablet, stamped with the station number 23105 in 1963.
